## If you pay tax in France

If you are a French taxpayer, you can claim a deduction of 66% of your charitable donations up to a maximum of 20% of your gross income from your final tax payable.

This means that, if you give by a regular standing order or virement from your French account, you could give three times as much as would have put in cash on the collection plate without it costing you any more, once your tax deduction is taken into account. For example, a regular donation of  $\[ \in \] 200$  per month would benefit the church by  $\[ \in \] 2,400$  a year, but may only cost you as little as  $\[ \in \] 816$  – the equivalent of less than  $\[ \in \] 16$  per week.

To make a tax-deductible regular contribution, simply set up a standing order or virement using your electronic banking or by visiting your branch, and please give our treasurer your address and email so that we can thank you and give you the certificate to claim your tax deduction shortly after the end of the year.
